



„Digital Nights“: The Best-of Shows from 10 Years of Kunstkraftwerk

Five multimedia shows celebrating the anniversary across 13 evenings in early summer

Intense visual experiences, new ways of engaging with art, and digital attractions within the walls of a historic industrial complex: For ten years, Kunstkraftwerk Leipzig has been enriching the city's exhibition landscape, positioning Leipzig as one of Europe's leading hubs for digital art. From mid-May, this anniversary will be celebrated through a series of multimedia retrospectives: the "Digital Nights" present selected highlight shows from recent years. In addition, the new presentation "Von Kohle zu Kunst" in the foyer offers first insights into an interactive discovery tour on the history of the former power plant, which will be available from July.

Experiencing art with all the senses and rediscovering works from new perspectives: this is the focus of the highlight shows presented in the Maschinenhalle on 13 evenings for the Kunstkraftwerk's tenth anniversary.

Two shows are dedicated to iconic figures in art history: "Monet Dreamscapes" and "Klimt Gold Experience." With Claude Monet, the Kunstkraftwerk celebrated the father of Impressionism in 2024 with the exhibition "Master of Colour and Light." In this show, the machine hall becomes a celebration of color and light. Gustav Klimt marked the beginning of modern painting at the end of the 19th century. The show, premiered in 2023, stages his life and work as a spectacular world of gold and color.

With "Bright Festival Connect," Kunstkraftwerk has established an internationally acclaimed festival for digital art, light design, and electronic music in Leipzig since 2020. Under the title "Bright Festival Selection," a 45-minute kaleidoscope will be presented for the anniversary, bringing together highlights from numerous past Bright Festival shows.

"Boomtown" traces the transformation of Leipzig's industrial culture – from a former production site to a diverse space for creative industries, leisure, and art. The show will be presented as a digital double feature with "Tübke Monumental," which makes Werner Tübke's monumental panorama painting "Early Bourgeois Revolution in Germany" accessible in a new, playful way on the walls of the Maschinenhalle.

Whether art lovers, culture enthusiasts, or friends of Kunstkraftwerk: the "Digital Nights" offer new insights and unforgettable memories for everyone. From 14 May to 2 July, the shows take place on Wednesdays from 6 to 8 pm and Thursdays from 8 to 9 pm, each featuring one show per evening. Admission is priced at a special rate of €12.50 (reduced €10). In keeping with the format, the entrance area will offer sparkling wine, popcorn, and a selection of additional snacks and beverages.
